DETAILS

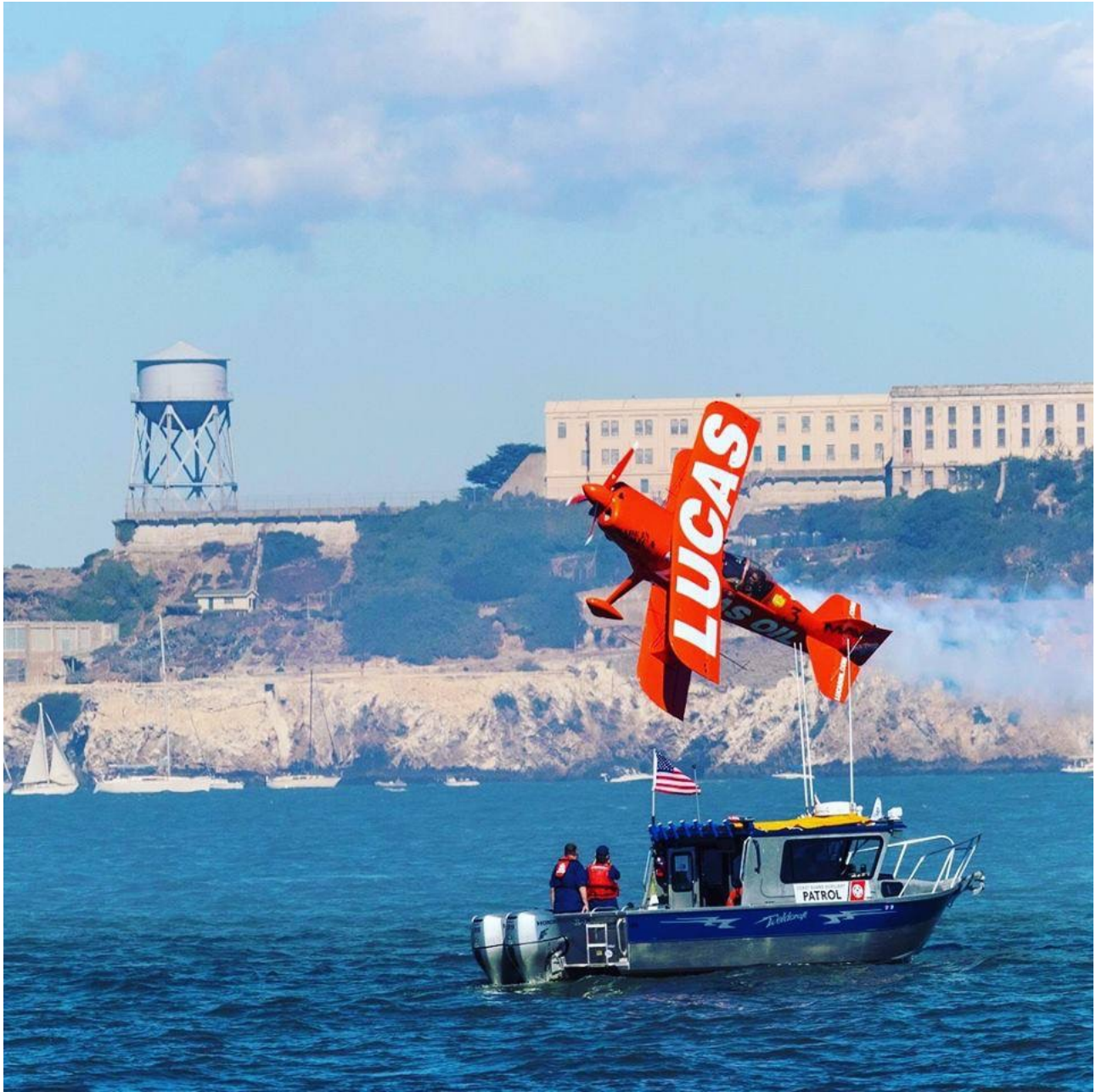
