- 1. Crew and Coxswain's Operation Workshop. Flotilla 7-8 Lana Visser, our division Public Affairs Officer will be leading a public affairs activity on May 21st from 5 P.M. to 7 P.M. at Wasatch County Safe Kids Fair in Heber City, Utah. We'll have a number of members from all Flotillas assisting and making this event successful
