<u>Highlights:</u>

- National Safe Boating Week
- New Levee Breaches on the Upper Sacramento River
- Division 3 has a PWC Coxswain

Details:

- Inclement weather curtailed nearly all of Division 3's planned NSBW activity, but we were able to secure space inside the Arden Fair Mall, which generated a fair amount of foot traffic. We were honored to be visited by Herself, COMO Mary Kirkwood at the event.
- Construction is complete on set-back levees on the west bank of the Sacramento River, about a mile downstream from Miller Park Boat Ramp and farther down. The old levee has been breached in three places, to allow high water to enter the area behind the old breaches and mitigate flooding and erosion. SO-NS (and DSO-NS) Jim Duncan has documented these for chart updating, but members are cautioned to watch for unexpected dead-ends in the area.
- After a many-year hiatus, Division 3 again has a PWC Facility, and a new PWC Coxswain. Congratulations to COX Johan Lai.

Projects

- Division Commander's member preparedness initiative: CERT preparedness course TBD
- Family Appreciation Day to coincide (roughly) with USCGAUX Birthday, 22 June, Folsom Lake
- SAR exercise to include air and surface assets is in the planing stages, and will probably start with a sand-table OPEX.

Challenges

- Recruitment and retention

- Delta Sailing School (ongoing) by 3-10
