Details:

- Kudos to John Hardin, owner and Coxswain of AUX Vessel *Side Kick*, for consistently serving the batting public. In June, he completed with patrols, and participated in four out of seventeen total SAR cases in STA Rio Vista's AOR.
- The California Capital Airshow is starting to ramp-up, ahead of the show dates of October 5 & 6. Division 3 has been invited to have a PA booth on both days of the show, and we have commitments to include a static display of an AUX surface facility, an AUX air facility, an HC-27J from AIRSTA Sacramento, and the ever-popular Coastie. (All subject to availability.)
- On June 22nd, the CCA organizers held a Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math event for local schoolchildren, and Flotilla 35's Bernard Brown attended. He operated a PA booth, made several recruiting contacts, and has established the Task Force for Division 3's participation at the Airshow.
