DETAILS:

- 1. 2020 Planning:** Our first meeting of the year was held on January 22nd, at Station Golden Gate. We were able to cover a lot of ground and completed our administrative set-up for 2020. The Board approved the 2020 Budget, completed the Audit for submission of the 2019 Year End Financials and Unit Inventory Record (Form #7025), approved the Annual Calendar, set the date for our next Joint COW, and discussed ideas for our 2020 Joint OPTREX with Division 12.
- 2. Joint COW-2020 Scheduled:** With the success of our first Joint COW in 2019, and following a thorough debrief of the event, the Division Board agreed to return to the Berkeley Yacht Club for our next Joint COW. The Berkeley Yacht Club has confirmed our reservation for Saturday, January 9th, 2021 @ 1100HRs. The event contract will follow for review by District Legal. District staff has been notified to calendar the event.
- 3. Joint OPTREX Planning with Division 12:** Next week Division 01 and 12 Leadership will begin the planning process for this year's Joint OPTREX. The event has been scheduled for Friday and Saturday, June 26-27 at Marina Bay Harbor, Richmond. Additional event details will be distributed as they become available.
- 4. Sector San Francisco-Replacement of AUX Flag:** IPDCDR Michael Mitchell brought to our attention that the Auxiliary Flag that flies at Sector San Francisco was in tatters and needed replacing. Funds for the Auxiliary Flag replacement were added to our approved Budget and IPDCDR Mitchell has confirmed that the replacement flag is now up and waving proudly at Sector SF.
