HIGHLIGHTS/"3 UPS":

- 1. 12-01 Prepared a set of member training videos
- 2. 12-91 registered for the San Ramon Art and Wind Festival

DETAILS:

- 1. 12-01 prepared training videos on the following topics: filling out a 7029, using Aux Directory, using AuxLMS, using AuxInfo, how to tie the knots for boat crew qualification
- 2. The Art and Wind Festival in San Ramon is the largest PA event of the year for flotilla 12-91. The flotilla reserved a 20x10 foot space for static display
- 3. 12-91's FSO-IS has input the hours for members in advance of the AUXDATA shutdown deadline

PROJECTS:
