HIGHLIGHTS/"3 UPS":

1. 12-01 Prepared a set of member training videos
2. 12-91 registered for the San Ramon Art and Wind Festival
3. 12-91 has input its hours before the AUXDATA shutdown deadline

DETAILS:

1. 12-01 prepared training videos on the following topics: filling out a 7029, using Aux Directory, using AuxLMS, using AuxInfo, how to tie the knots for boat crew qualification
2. The Art and Wind Festival in San Ramon is the largest PA event of the year for flotilla 12-91. The flotilla reserved a 20x10 foot space for static display
3. 12-91's FSO-IS has input the hours for members in advance of the AUXDATA shutdown deadline

PROJECTS:
