This last drowning was a result of a PWC operator with a passenger both not wearing life jackets taking a hard turn getting tossed into the water and one did not resurface. the passenger swam to shore at Yuba Lake last Saturday.

We've have had: 2 drownings at Utah Lake. 2 at Lake Powell. 1 at the Great Salt Lake

1 drowning at Yuba Lake. 1 at Quail Creek Reservoir. for a total of 7 so far this year.

last year we had nine. The season is just starting.
