DETAILS:

- 1. Flotilla 6-10 Boating Skills and Safety Classes were completed on 12 August when an online final exam was provided to over a dozen students. Wally Smith, assisted by Chuck Cobery, led the final two regular classes -- suspended due to COVID-19 which were completed in a virtual classroom prior to the exam.
- 2. Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic the OPTREX scheduled for September has been cancelled.
- 3. Division 6 Auxiliarists have begun taking advantage of the few activities opened by DIRAUX. Within the Division three boat safety examinations were completed and Ray David and Tom Stead conducted 10 Marine Dealer Visits in July. Additionally, Bruce Simpson reports that he verified six aids to navigation in the Aptos and Santa Cruz area. Great job folks!
