3. We are transitioning to live in-person activities where permitted by Phase 3 Guidelines. This includes Patrols, Boat Crew Training, VE's, PV's, PA events. Our NSBW Activities will transition mostly to live events where permitted. It looks like Division 5 and its Flotilla's will look to start Hybrid meetings which will include in-person and online components in August as we all usually go dark in July. We are planning one more Virtual PE ABS Class with FC 53 Kit Galvin is organizing the Class 24-28 May--We need student support This will be last ABS class. Also, BRAVO ZULU to Wil Sumner who continues to put on a virtual Marine Safety qualification classes—See Webinar calendar for details. We encourage all members to take advantage of Webinars and live activities. Our patrol season is underway with FL 55 and Fl 53 having multiple approved patrols and completing some PATONS and Bridge Verifications. Now that the Patrol Crew Bubble has burst we have more flexibility with who we can include as crew and trainees, So if you are due Requal or are working on initial Quals or just seeking to get your 12- hour minimum underway time in Contact Wil Sumner FL 55 or Lew Derfuss SO-OP 5 and make your needs known. We all are rusty after over a year of no patrol activities and we need to train to get prepared for QE Check rides. We are tentatively looking to schedule Annual Division 5 Luau on Saturday 10 July at Derfuss Ranch in Vacaville CA pending continuing lifting of Corina Virus Restrictions and DIRAUX Approval.

PROJECTS:

- 1. We have scheduled on District calendar--2021 COW for Division 5 for 5 Dec and a Fall OPTREX hosted by FL 55 at Sta Bodega Bay 24-26 Sep. With progress of moving to Phase 3 we are hopeful these events will happen.
- 2. Members working on updating PPE inspections and completing 2021 Operations workshop and TCT/Risk Management Refreshers
- 3. NSBW being lead by Bob Schabert, VDCDR 5 Ingemar Ollson, and representatives from each Flotilla. Bob is also planning to approach local government officials to have proclamations prepared. All plans have shifted back to Plan A which will allow limited in person contact. See Phase 3 Guidelines.
- 4. It was decided to cancel our annual Golf Fundraiser this year and look into another way to hopefully raise money to support our local CG Stations Morale Funds.

CHALLENGES/OBSTACLES/OPPORTUNITIES:

1. <u>VE restrictions to 3 a day per inspector—Posses a real hinderance to all VE planned activities. We</u> would hope that National rescind this limit of 3

- 3. Phase has again given us more flexibility to preform some traditional missions and opportunities to meet in person and socialize.
- 4. Cancelled PCA Fairs, DTRAIN,-- Emphasis now on NSBW, OPTREX's, Fall PCA Fair and COWS
- 5. <u>Training and scheduling 29 required 2021 requalification check rides as well as initial qualification of Coxswains and Boat Crew members.</u>
- 6. <u>Focus on individual Flotilla strengths and combined and open up and communicate training opportunities among Flotilla's, combining efforts to achieve maximum results.</u>

AGENCY INTERACTION:

1. Looking forward to again working closely with Sta Vallejo, Sta Rio Vista and Sta Bodega Bay staff in providing Operational Support with Joint Patrols to support both CG Station and Division Boat Crew Training, Qualification, and Currency by providing AUXFAC's and Crews upon request as well as routine support to AOR as allowed. One requirement to interact with Active Duty Station personnel is that ALL Auxiliary Crew Members that interact BE VACINATED against Covid Virus.
