HIGHLIGHT DETAILS:

- 1. Immediately following our online May meeting, Paul Vervienotis held an excellent Ops refresher class that was attended by several members.
- 2. On May 28, Derek Chan, FC Palo Alto, and Eddie Lam, VCDR Division South Bay, presented two wreaths on behalf of our division to the VA Hospital in Menlo Park. Accepting the wreaths for the VA was Joseph Yang, one of the coordinators for social activities for the veterans. The veterans greatly appreciated that their comrades-in-arms that have passed on were not forgotten despite all of the CoVid restrictions (see photo below).
- 3. Our division did not hold any formal National Safe Boating Week events/activities, but four of us did participate in Division Gold Coast's event at Santa Cruz Harbor on May 22. Alan Stanton and Mike Brown supported the event by doing a short patrol with Chuck Cobery on *Mei Long*, and then attended that facility while it was moored at the harbor launch ramp (see photo below). We interacted with the public and harbor officials at that location for the duration of the event that day, and Mike Brown was able to conduct two VSCs there. Later that day, 2 members of Flotilla Silicon Valley (Judy Esteban and BK Barr) joined the Gold Coast crew in the public relations efforts by the Auxiliary Communications Van that was parked by the launch ramp as part of the static displays by Division Gold Coast, Santa Cruz Harbor Patrol, and Tow Boat U.S.
