3. California Capital Air Show scheduled for 24-26 September 2021. Two 10' x 10' spaces acquired, CG Recruiting office Alameda participating.

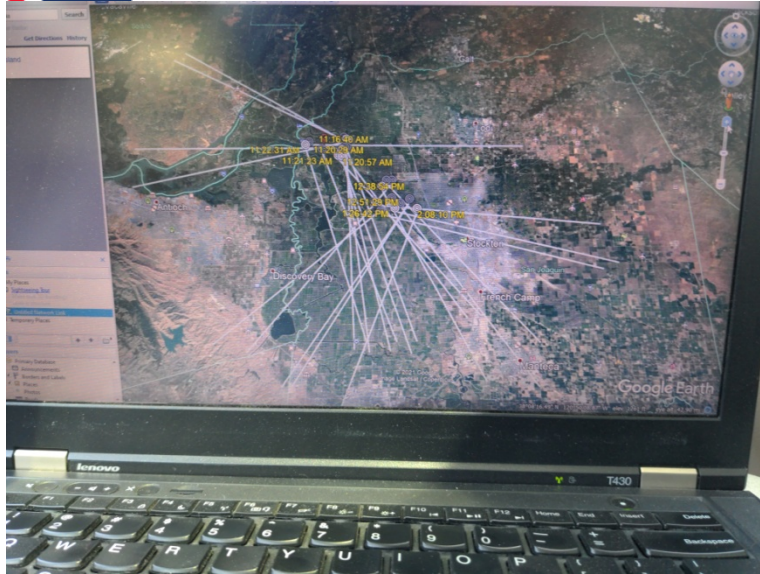
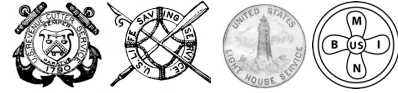
Goals and Objectives:
