Details

1. With 72 without a FC and VFC we hosted 72 Meeting to help with staff officers positions and start to lay out on planning upcoming events. This is to help the Flotilla in moving forward and keeping the members active and engaged.
2. Flotilla 73 held a Boating class with 29 participants graduating and 25 of them under 18 years of age. This was the 8-hour class.
3. Flotilla 78, Participated in the Be Safe Utah Expo Event. This event covered Preparedness, Health, & Safety. There both focused on Life jacket safety and how to Choose the right life jacket. This was a 2-day event Feb. 25, & 26 with several thousand spectators. It was well received.
4. The latest statistics for UTAH's 2022 water levels are that we will start out the boating season at 10% less water than last year.
5. Upcoming Events
 - a. VALKY Race June 18, 2022 This event will cover two lakes Jordanelle and Deer Creek. Reservoir. What is VALKY. The Valkyrie Relay spans nearly 110 miles of Utah's spectacular 'Wasatch Back' mountain range. The event pits teams of up to 9 specialized competitors, each racing against the clock and exchanging between trail running, kayak/canoe paddling, road running, mountain biking, stand-up paddle boarding, open water swimming, and road cycling. Division 7 has been asked to support both lakes this year.
 - b. Beach Cleanup With the Sea Scouts at Utah Lake at 3 of the Beaches. Help set up Life Jacket Stands and 250 Life jackets we're donated for the Life Jacket stands.
 - c. Highlighting again: Division 7 has been asked to Participate in the Warriors Over The Wasatch air show. We have been asked to have a booth with static

displays of out patrol vessels at the air show. They will have Demonstrations from the USAF Thunderbirds and F-35A Lightning II Demonstration Team and much, much, more! They estimate to have attendance to be 60,000 to 80,000 during the 2 day event. The date will be June 25-26.
