- 1. **VSC Day at Lock Lomond YC**: 12 VSCs completed on 30 Mar 2024, courtesy Greg Catani (Lead) along with vessel examiners VNACO Mary Kirkwood, Chris Armbrust, Nancy Marion and Carol Paz all of FL 01-04.
- 2. **Operations**: OPFAC Silver Charm continues to support ASSF in helo-ops patrols with 10 patrols completed since March 1st. Additionally, a boat-crew training patrol on March 16th was followed by a successful check-ride patrol completed on 6 April (see 4. Bravo Zulu below.)
- 3. **2024 NSBW**: One of our largest events, the annual **Water Safety Fair** at Station Golden Gate in support of National Safe Boating Week, set for Saturday, May 18th from 1000-1300. This event is sponsored by FL 01-02 with assistance from our Division 1 (and D11) membership.
- 4. **Bravo Zulu:** Thomas Nuckton, MD (01-02), for advancing from AP status on 3/11/24 to BQ status by 3/29/24. Challenges and Obstacles

- 1. Limited number of qualified instructors, vessel examiners, program visitors as well as FSOs restrict flotilla RBS related activities
- 2. PPE AD2 updating maintenance tedious to verify/track
- 3. AUXDATA II hours entry compliance
- 4. Succession planning remains an ongoing challenge at the flotilla level

Goals and Objectives

- 1. Advance member goals-special emphasis on mentor assignments
- 2. **Enhance training opportunities**-surface operations "Work Smarter" initiative, which incorporates annual TASK maintenance training during routine MOM/NAV patrols.
- 3. **Amplify USCG Auxiliary recruitment-**currently with over a dozen prospective members throughout our Division's four flotillas in various stages of the application process, we hope to see a modest improvement in succession planning
