HIGHLIGHTS/"3 UPS":

DETAILS:

- 1. MOM, PATON, training and special events patrols are on the schedule. A number of VSCs were performed at several boat rental facilities, led by SO-MS Tom Temkin. These make up a huge share of Div 11 VSCs and continue good relationships with rental fleet operators.
