Details

- 1. On Monday, May 13, 2024 Division 7 was honored to participate in the memorial service for retired 23-year Auxiliary member Dick Hoelle. He was also a veteran of the US Navy and served on the Enterprise. We were grateful that the service was attended by Paul and Sherry Custance, Comm Mike Williams, Riley and Nada Turpin, Elliot Moses, Ammon Thompson, and myself. He was a bigger than life individual with a wonderful sense of humor and dedication to service. He served as VFC, FC, VDCR and DCDR and completed over 600 SAR's in his service to Utah. He will be missed.
- 2. Lana Visser and John Michael Zimmerle provided a very successful presentation of the Coastie Water Safety PA event at the Eagle Mountain Black ridge Elementary School to several hundreds of parents and children.
- 3. We have been invited to participate at an employee Safety Event for Intermountain Rigging in SLC on June 14th. We have been asked to provide instruction on water safety and particularly proper life jacket procedures. Although this may seem to be an unusual subject for a rigging company, we have been told that many employees have boats stored at the facility which provides an opportunity to offer VE's as well as a recruiting opportunity.
- 4. The prospect of collecting used life jackets for loaner stations at Utah lakes is meeting with positive results. Although the concept is worthy of pursuing, it is not feasible to launch a program this season. However, this gives us adequate time to create an organized plan, obtain corporate sponsors for drop off locations and develop a comprehensive media

campaign. There will be great opportunities for exposure for the auxiliary, recruit new members and develop additional skills with our PA staff.
