### **DSO-MS updates**

Divisions 1,5,6,8,10,12 report AWW contacts, Dock Walker contacts, Abandoned/Derelict Vessel sightings, Ferry Vessel audits, Dock cleanups, MS course completions and PA events.

### **Ferry Vessel Audits**

Steve Johnson ADSO reports 7 audits were done in late August. Two teams were out with one completing 4 Audits and the other with 3 audits. One trainee participated.

### **Commercial Vessel activity**

#### **Commercial Fish**

Wil Sumner reports 5 CFV exams were done at Bodega by Wil S. and Curtis Han.

### **Uninspected Passenger Vessels**

No exams were done since the August Report. A class covering UPV will be held at Sector Humboldt by Michael Mitchell.

### **IMD support & Prevention Training**

Wil Sumner ADSO reports the Agency partners meeting covered a presentation on the National Strategy Recommendations for dealing with Abandoned/Derelict Vessels. 30-50 years ago underground tanks were constructed and then began leaking petroleum products. The use of Oil Spill Liability Trust Fund (OSLTF) funds cleaned up the existing sites, but now any new sites require insurance and bonds for the companies building them. It is illegal to see commercial vessels to private parties and for the US Government to sell military vessels to private individuals.

The next meeting will be 22 October in Hercules.

There will be a number of MS classes given at PCA next weekend 8/9 Sept. MEES, Hazwoper (required for SCAT training), and UPV.
