ANALYSIS

- Although students and graduates are down from 2016 and 2017, the more important thing to notice is that number of course completions is up from both of those years. Because Division 12's large youth courses swamp all other activity in terms of counting students and graduates, number of course completions is a better indicator of the overall level of PE activity throughout our district.
- Our national rankings stayed stable from last month. As noted in earlier



reports, our ranking may improve slightly once we successfully get Division 3's PE activity entered into AuxData.
