ANALYSIS

- Although we are on the same space for course completions as last year, that puts us only 12th in the nation (out of 16 districts). A goal for 2019 will be to increase course completions, even if flotillas are offering courses to only five students at a time. This should be attainable if flotillas make an effort to offer A Paddler's Guide to Safety, which is a high-priority, low-overhead course that can be offered in 20 minutes to two hours.
- Our national rankings stayed stable from last month. As noted in earlier



reports, our ranking may improve slightly once we successfully get Division 3's PE activity entered into AuxData.
