#### **Topic Details:**

- 1 Government Shutdown
  - 1.1 During this Government Shutdown, Gerald R. (Randy) Patton, DIR-U sent out the following to all DSO-CS officers. I have forwarded his email to all CS officers in our District asking them to forward as needed.
    - 1.1.1 "There seems to be some confusion amongst the troops on what they can do during the government shutdown. Online/telephone meetings are perfectly acceptable. It's also fine for people to continue to work on their projects from their home/office. I confirmed that this is the case with NACO last week.

  - 3.2.1 The format for sending out group email is <u>div#@d11nuscgaux.info</u>, replace the "#" with the unit number i.e. <u>div7@d11nuscgaux.info</u> for Division 7 or <u>div10@d11nuscgaux.info</u> for division 10.
  - 3.2.2 Only the Division DCDR and VCDR have rights to use this services.
  - 3.2.3 Keep in mind that this is a distribution lists and will not receive replies from anyone on the list.

# 4 DTRAIN CS Class Set

- 4.1 The class that will be offered at DTRAIN have been set. The District DSO-CS will be teaching the following.
  - 4.1.1 Free Apps for the Auxiliaries
    - 4.1.1.1 The cost of software has gone up 34% over the past few years. In order to keep end users coming back most of the big boys have gone to pay as you go to hide the real cost. To keep users coming back Internet roamers are pushed out about how dangerous it is to use free or open source software. In this class, we are going to take an in-depth look at some of the best open source software out there. We will talk about the real risk of using free software and we will expose the truth about using open source software and the inherent shortfalls. This class may save you \$100s of dollars without giving up any ability. You may just deceiver that open source software can do more for you. This class is a bring your own device (BYOD) if you want to play along, not required. You will need to have either OpenOffice or

LibreOffice pre-loaded. The other free software that we will be looking into is Google Photo, Google Drive and Google Calendar.

- 4.1.2 Google Photo, More Than Just a Photo Album
  - 4.1.2.1 In this class, we are going to look at what Google Photos offers and what you can do with it. We going to look beyond the unlimited storage and into such things as albums, adding text, and even using Google Photos as a presentation package. We are going to talk about how your unit can build up a library of how-to videos and/or photos. Just how to share albums and allow anyone to upload photos into your album. When you're done with this class you're going to see a new and more powerful way to move, store, share, and even use your photos, videos, and presentations. You will never again attach photos to an email and wonder if it's too big to send. You will know how to make a real-time shared album that others can see and use your photos as you upload them. This class is a bring your own device (BYOD) if you want to play along, not required. You will need to have Google Photos pre-loaded we will not be installing it in class.
- 4.1.3 Communications Services (WOW)
  - 4.1.3.1 We have been given special access to the AUX-04 class site and will be using it. Therefor, this will be a hands-on class. The AUX-04 class does not get into Smart Tags, but in this class we will be taking a look into how to use this powerful tool. This maybe a one-time only offer so I encourage all CS officers to join me as we look deep into how WoW works.
    - 4.1.3.2 If you are a CS officer or you want to know more about what the CS team does. This is the class for you. The class is designed to take anyone from beginner to expert as a WOW technician. You will learn how the WoW website actually works. Learn what the pitfalls are and how to work around them. How to use the in-bedded tools to make it work for you. We will cover Smart Tags and how they can make your site work with the users. Get closeup with the WoW site so you will have a better understanding of just what WoW can do for your unit. WoW, the public window to your unit and the information portal of your unit in one place. This class is a bring your own device (BYOD) if you want to play along, not required. We are going to try and get a test WoW site set up for this class, if we can't it will be a look and don't touch. You may work on your own site, but it's not recommended.

# 5 When an Auxiliary Web Site Does Not Look Right

- 5.1 If you have not had problems opening an Auxiliary web site you may at some point. Most of the time when you see any loading or opening problems there are some steps you can take before contacting your unit's CS officer.
  - 5.1.1 Check is it just your units site that having problems? See if you can open some other Auxiliary's site. Next, are you the only one having the problem? It maybe something on your own device. Ether try the same site from some other device or call someone and have them try the same site. If the other device or person does not have a problem then it's most likely something with your own device. If they do see the same problem it's time to call your CS officer.
