Everbridge Exercise January

Out of 1234 members, 855 confirmed + 76 late (75.4%). Slow improvement. Next all-district exercise in July.

There will be no Everbridge exercise in February.

News from National – (my notes in bold.)

The NTRAIN, or National Board Meeting, took place in St Louis last week. Several items related to Incident Management & Preparedness were taken up by NEXCOM and BSX.

1. A new policy has been implemented to replace the mandatory ICS core courses for new members and those assuming roles in appointed / elected positions. **Essentially ICS 100 and 700 will only be required when you obtain certain qualifications (e.g. Boat crew).**



2. TCT is now termed *Risk Management*. **We will offer the new course at D-Train; take the online first.**

3. The Incident Management Auxiliary Coordination Cell (IMACC) concept continues to be refined and has the full support of NEXCOM and Coast Guard Headquarters (BSX and CPE). We will keep you apprised as of developments as they occur. **This is the group that coordinated AUX response to an incident and ICS organization.**

4. BSX approved the Auxiliary instructing ICS-300 with input and approval of a final lesson plan and policy from TRACEN York Town. The Q Department is the lead. **A modified FEMA version.**
