
4. U.S. Coast Pilot® now contains Coast Guard navigation rules

Posted on March 28, 2019 by NOAA Office of Coast Survey

NOAA recently announced that all nine <u>United States Coast Pilot®</u> volumes now contain the U.S. Coast Guard International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea (72 COLREGS) and the Inland Navigation Rules — commonly known as the "<u>Rules of the Road</u>." The navigation rules are similar to rules on the highway as they present a consistent way to navigate safely and avoid collisions. Having the newly published Coast Pilot now fulfills the legal requirement for mariners to maintain a copy of these regulations on board.

The newly added USCG regulations are found in Appendix B of all nine Coast Pilot volumes. Appendix B reformatting is standard across all volumes. The climatological and meteorological tables once found in Appendix B are now located within each corresponding chapter (geographic area) of each respective Coast Pilot volume. The Tips for Boating Clean and Green section is now located in chapter one of each Coast Pilot volume.

This change stemmed through a working arrangement with the USCG and NOAA by means of updating, improving, and modernizing the USCG navigation rules.



Appendix B located in all nine Coast Pilot volumes.

Coast Pilot is a series of sailing directions that supplement nautical charts. Each volume covers a separate geographical region, and contains navigation regulations, facility locations, weather information, and other topics critical to safe navigation

If you would like to attend one of these two C-Schools, you must get your Schools "Short Term Training Request Form CG-5223" into DIRAUX (Tina Perry) ASAP. The websites below will give all the information you will need to attend the 2019 AUX 06 Course. You can also contact DSO-NS for course content and schedules and more updated information from Ed Martin DVC-PN.

ATON C-School Program:

You will receive over twenty-five hours of instruction covering the NS programs. All the required material for the program will be available for download and review from the following site: http://wow.uscgaux.info/content.php?unit=AUX06&category=forms-manuals
You are not required to download the forms and study guides for this class. There will be minimal paper handouts at the C-School. It is recommended that you print out the training guides for reference if you do not plan to bring a laptop. The latest versions of the material will be available on this website one week before class begins. You will need to familiarize yourself with this data before arriving at the school:

About the Course:

This school is designed to provide training in all five Auxiliary Navigation Systems Programs ATON Federal Short-Range Aid to Navigation Program, PATON -Private Aids to Navigation, BAP Bridge Administration Program, CU Chart Updating Program including CP Coast Pilot Program. The aim of the Navigation Systems "C" School is to train a cadre of Auxiliary leaders who will promote the Navigation Systems programs in their District and develop new and lasting programs and relationships with the Coast Guard & NOAA-Office of Coast Survey in support of the goals and objectives of the Auxiliary Aid to Navigation, Bridges, & Chart Updating Program. There are 2 classes, 15 Students each, scheduled in 2019.

Who May Attend:

Candidates must be recently assigned as an FSO-NS (Flotilla Staff Officer - Navigation Systems), SO-NS (Division Staff Officer - Navigation Systems), or a DSO or ADSO-NS (District Staff Officer - Navigation Systems). This training is not refresher training. Alternative training is available through your District Navigation Systems program managers. COMDT (CG-5421) must approve all waivers. Applicants MUST have an internet e-mail account capable of receiving and downloading attachments to order and to benefit most from this training. Therefore, the candidate's e-mail address must be included in Block #22 of the Short-Term Resident Training Request prior to approval.

<u>How to apply</u> for C-School: Complete the "Short Term Resident Training Request" (STTR) Form CG-5223 from the above web-site under **How To Apply**. Send your completed CG-5223 form to your District DIRAUX (Director of Auxiliary) - (Tina Perry) via your Flotilla Commander (your FC is required to sign the form). Keep a copy of the Form CG-5223. Expect to receive travel and information about orders.

Priority codes for Block 15 on the form are:

Priority 1 – All recently assigned Navigation Systems Staff Officers who holds AV-PQS qualification;

Priority 2 – All Navigation Systems Staff Officers who does NOT hold AV-PQS qualification;

Priority 3 – All others based on available space.

Remember there are only 15 students per school so early registration is suggested.
