- 1. To make our website technologies more compatible with latest web standards.
- 2. Improve the ability of our site when displayed on mobile devices like smartphones and tablets, as much as possible with in the limits of WOW. This is particularly important to members who access the Internet through mobile devices.
- 3. Make it easy to add and update content on-the-fly.
- 4. Line up content with members needs and post the content where it's more fitting.
- 5. Add features to our site like calendars, forms, social buttons, forms, and other similar features that will same time and add value to it's use to the members.
- 6. Improve access security to content by controlling who can see the content.
- 7. Exploit the real power of WOW and it's ability to interface with AUXDATA.

Web technologies have changed enormously in the past few years. Many sites are moving from HTML and Flash sites to content management sites. The changes you have seen in our site this year is just that. We are moving to a content driven site and way from the older way of doing things. With change come some learning. I ask that you give this format a chance.

The rules for a content management site, our District site, are simple. It follows the chain of leadership, i.e. COMO owns the home page, DCapt own the next level down and under each of the DCapt come the DSO pages. Therefore, if your looking for something just ask under whom do these things fall. There are a few things like calendar, Board and Staff, member items, and some public content that have their own level two page.
