- Sector SF Staff and AUX Coordinators are working diligently on planning 4 days of AUX support to Fleet Week - our traditional vessel, comms, and on shore activities. AUX is also planning to support CG Cutter COBB Fleet Week guest rides with AUX safety officers and food services assistance.
- From Sector SF: *“At the request of VTS, D11N AUX activated Mount Diablo repeater, enabling VTS comms with vessel traffic in the delta. Mr. Cassidy, the AUX watch stander at Sector SF, had the site up in less than 10 minutes. On the first day, there were two down river transits, one from Stockton and one from Antioch. Comms were perfect. We have permission to use the repeater for “as long as necessary” according to Mr. Cassidy.”*
- **Delta Blitz over Labor Day Weekend.** Multiple AUX participated at request of San Joaquin County Sheriff providing Vessel Exams and Public Affairs displays, as well as safety patrols throughout the Delta AOR.
- AUX San Ramon Valley Flotilla sponsored 34 Young Marines (ages 8-11) and 3 adult chaperones at Sector SF and CGSTA SF on 17AUG for an all-day event including presentations on CG activities, which included a ride on a Response Boat-Medium, training in heaving lines, training in the P6 dewatering pump, and two chapters of the Auxiliary boating safety course
