An IMACC was stood up at the FEMA National Response Coordination Center (NRCC). We had 6 AUX members for the FEMA National Response Coordination Center in Washington, D.C. Two IMACC members are standing watch today at the NRCC for a 7 day deployment.

There was a request for <u>ICS Qualified</u> AUX personnel interested and able to deploy for 14 days minimum.

Resource Unit Leaders - RESL3
Documentation Unit Leaders - DOCL3
Demobilization Unit Leaders - DEMOB3
Marine Transportation Recover Unit - MTSRU3
Area Agency Representatives - AREP
Safety Officers

This provided us some good insight into what data we need to have on our members (e.g. ICS quals), and what training and qualification directions we should consider. Offering the classes will be straightforward, it will be getting taskbooks signed off that needs development. I hope to discuss with D11 active duty staff when I visit CGI for EPLO work.
