1. THE VERIFYING PRIVATE AIDS SEASON IS 100% COMPLETED:

How is you Division doing so far this year? Well, that's what this report/bulletin is all about. <u>Again another 100% completion by all Division's this year</u> of our Coast Guard Eleventh District (dpw) bridge surveys and private aid verification assignments on time and under budget. To all the 2019 Navigation Systems Team consisting of A) Certified PQS Aid verifiers, B) FSO-NS's, C) SO-NS' and Area Coordinators, D) Coxswains using their vessels as aid verifier platform and E) Last but not lest the D11 (dpw) staff for all their assistances in contributed to 1003 bridge, ATON and PATON reports for another great year. BROVO ZULU to all.

It is important to understand that the Navigation Systems provides a multi-faceted program each year that breaks down into four categories to achieve the **1003** reports this year to date.

1. <u>Annual Bridge Survey Plan</u>: Bridges may be surveyed all year with a focus on the spring months. Our assignment goal was to complete 52 assigned surveys by May 31st and to date with a year total of 60 surveys.

2. <u>Annual Private Aid Verifications Plan</u>: Private aids (PATON) may be surveyed all year with a goal to complete 759 assigned PATON's by September 30th. We completed 100% of are assignment goal by completing all 759 assigned verifications by September 30th and to date with a year total of 790 PATON's.

3. <u>Non-permitted Private Aids Program Plan</u>: It's important to identify these aids and report them to the Coast Guard D11 (dpw). Many of these non-permitted private aids have been identified and converted to permitted private aids or removed from the waterways. To date we have located and reported 147 non-permitted private aids this year. Non-permitted private aids are a hazard to navigation.

4. <u>Chart Update & Coast Pilot Program</u>: It's upon us to make sure that our charts & coast pilot is update and accurate in AOR for safety to the boating public. It's important and an obligation for boating safety when we see or find errors to our charts or coast pilot and report them to NOAA. D113 submitted 4 Chart Updates & 1 Coast Pilot reports to date. We still have the last quarter to go.

Check page 2 to see what AUXDATA info. is recorded for your division, flotilla and individuals for Navigation Systems activity to date. District wide we have only recorded 67% of the actual NS activity to date.

Question: Have you submitted your Navigation Systems 7030 reports and your name is not on the table above? Is the data above incorrect? If so, then you have not submitted a 7030 or all of your 7030's for your Navigation Systems activity to be entered by your FSO-IS. If you have submitted all your 7030's for your Navigation Systems activities, then check with your FSO-IS Officer for the answer. Again, the FSO-IS, SO-IS & DSO-IS is the only members that can enter your Navigation Systems activity into AUXDATA.

NOTE: All Navigation Systems activity awards for this year and AV certifications for next year is taken from AUXDATA information. Remember the old saying "If it's not in AUXDATA it didn't happen." That is why you should always check the table above each month. So, this way you can see that if you have not reported your NS activity (7030) to your FSO-IS or they have not entered your NS activity incorrectly you have time for them to correct your information into AUXDATA. The FSO-IS or SO-IS is the only member that can enter and correct your Navigation Systems activity into AUXDATA and only you can let the FSO-IS or SO-IS if the data information is incorrect.

4. BECOME AUXILIARY AIDS TO NAVIGATION (ATON) VERIFIER: Any

Auxiliarist who would like to assist the Coast Guard in keeping our district waterways safe for navigation? We need your help in keeping all our bridges & aids to navigation watching properly. The auxiliary is task with verifying annually over 750+ private aids to navigation (PATON) and surveying 52 bridges each year that they are watching properly. We also report any non-permitted PATONs and Coast Guard's ATON discrepancies found. The only way we can carry out our districts missions is to have properly trained aid verifiers in each division.

The training requirements to become an "<u>Auxiliary Aids to Navigation (ATON) Verifier PQS</u>" is in the AV-PQS sign off booklet:

1) Complete all Tasks in the AV-<u>PQS sign off booklet</u>. All Major Tasks can be signed off by any Certified Aid Verifier except for Tasks 3.6, 5.1, 5.2, 5.3, 6.6. The 5 excepted Tasks is 5 scenarios that must be signed-off by the DSO-NS.

2) BQ or AX member,

3) Complete the Risk Management RM-100202 on-line Course & within 15 month the RM2.0 -4-hour TCT,

4) Completing ICS 100 and ICS 700,

5) Up to date on all Core Value Training.
