Subj: April 2020 D11NR DSO-PE Report

COVID-19: Per Admiral Gautier's D11NR March 15 stand-down order, all in-person PE activities are cancelled. Remote-taught PE classes are permitted and encouraged (see Special Interim COVID Remote-Ops Award below). However, the stand-down order prevents the required in-person proctoring of the closed-book exams for our two NASBLA-certified courses, ABS and BS&S.

On April 3, we notified all SO-PEs and FSO-PEs that one possible option is to teach ABS and BS&S remotely, but then have students complete the free, take-at-home "California Course for Safe Boating" exam in order to receive NASBLA credit. We also discussed this and other possible solutions on an April 7 conference call.

On April 15, the national E Directorate held a conference call that discussed best practices for teaching classes over the computer. One of the topics was the end-of-course exams for ABS and BS&S. We learned that the approvals for variations to the in-person proctor requirement will be on a state-by-state basis. As we receive updates, we will send them to the SO-PEs and FSO-PEs. If your division does not have a PE officer, please consider appointing one to receive these emails, if nothing else.

Special Interim COVID Remote-Ops Award: A special BZ goes to Flotilla 14 (Central Marin) and Flotilla 67 (Santa Cruz) for being the two flotillas with post-March 16 PE hours recorded in AuxData. (We realize there are other flotillas out there with hours to put into AuxData once the conversion to AuxData II is complete.)
