Commercial Fishing Vessel and Uninspected Passenger Vessel Examinations.

Sector has approved "Virtual" Commercial and UPV Exams to be conducted by approved examiners. We cannot use ZOOM, for security issues, but can use Google Duo or Face Time apps. This timing could have been better as both commercial and recreational salmon and ground fisheries opened up on May 1. So far we have received over 12 requests for CFV and UPV exams. UPV operators cannot take on passengers until the state6 foot social distancing is lifted.

MEES, MSAM and HAZWOPER Operations

District Marine Safety Team (Aux Sue Fry, MSTC Jeremy Thomas and Aux Wil Sumner) provided three Marine Safety webinars in April and May; Marine Safety Administration and Management (MSAM),. Aux Prevention Outreach Specialist (MEES) and 8 Hour Hazwoper Operations Classes. These webinar based classes were well attended with 23 Participants for MSAM, 25 Participants for MEES, and 28 Participants in the HAZWOPER Operations classes.
