DSO MS Missions

Ferry Boat Exam Status:

Commander Rivera has approved the Ferry boat program materials and has allowed the trial period for Ferry Boat Outreach to start. Aux Michael Mitchell has prepared the No Cost Orders Paperwork which should go out shortly. Based on the COVID -19 standing orders issues, the exam hopefully should start in Juy

Commercial Fishing Vessel and Uninspected Passenger Vessel Examinations.

Sector approved "Virtual" Commercial and UPV Exams to be conducted by approved examiners in April. The most successful virtual exams have been done using Facetime or Goggle Duo. So far Disistrict 11 NR has completed 15 Commercial Fishing Vessel Exams and 4 UPV.. D11NR is the only Cg District that adopted the virtual exam process.

UPV operators can now take on passengers but must adhere to 6 feet of railing per passenger. This means that most "6" pack boats are really "4" pack boats.
