Accomplishments by the ADSO and Division Marine Safety Staff Officers

All SO MS officers have contributed immensely to the Marine safety efforts in 2021 with the increased number of Beach and Shoreline Cleanups, our Sea Partner hours and member activity in Marine safety overall have surpassed 2020 numbers. Also with the SO MS officers promoting the Marine Safety program in general, we had 6 members complete the Marine Safety Training Ribbon in 2021. Congratulations to Arnold Gelb, Bernard Brown, John Teague, Joseph Chavoen, Bill Hale, and Dean McFarren for reaching this goal.

The ADSO MS officers that served in 2021 have also done an outstanding job in promoting the MS mission. Sue Fry and Quindy Sammler helped tremendously in helping put on the 4 MEES and MSAM classes. Joseph Chavoen has been taking over the management of the Abandoned Derelict Vessel program and representing the CG Auxiliary well at the ADV Quarterly Stakeholders meeting. Finally, Michael Mitchell has done a great job in coordinating the UPV program for the CG Auxiliary at Sector San Francisco. We will be using Michael as a role model for the new AUC-UPV position at Sector Columbia River in District 13.

DSO & ADSO Activities

Michael Mitchell and the Branch Chiefs for National Prevention, Vessel Activities completed the new Uninspected Passenger Vessel, (UPV) PQS which was submitted to National.

The DSO MS for both D11NR (Wil Sumner) plus D13 (Jim Fenske) have been working on getting the UPV examination program started in D13, or principally in Sector Columbia River. D13 has never had a UPV program as no Auxiliarist has stepped up to take on the AUC position at Sector specifically for UPV. Chuck McCarty has taken that position (a former D11NR Auxiliarist). The first meet and greet to discuss the organization of the UPV program was held on November 19, December 19 and the next follow up meeting is February 1, 2022...

The next ADV meeting is scheduled for January 12.

Marine Safety Classes for 2022

It is the intention of the Marine Safety and Environmental Protection Unit of the Prevention Department, to continue to offer the following classes in 2022, hopefully in person beginning with D-Train and then through out the year through the Fall PCA Fair

These courses will include Intro to Marine Safety D11N, MEES, MSAM, Sea Partners, UPV Intro, CFV Intro, HAZWHOPER Awareness, and HAZWHOPER Operations, to name a few, as We have in the Past. We are planning offering 2 to 3 Classes at D-Train in MAR. Then working in Conjunction with USCG Station Rio Vista we would like to Offer our MESS and MSAM Courses as in the Past. We shall then Facilitate additional Class Offerings for the Fall PCA Fair. Specific Course offering for D-Train, Virtual Online, and the Fall PCA Fair are yet to be determined, and shall be in FEB when DSO-MS Chavoen holds a virtual Meeting with Continuing and New ADSO's MS.

Additionally we look forward to continue working with the CA Division of Boating and Waterways with Their Northern CA Dockwalker Trainings, All Virtual (5 MAR, 2 APR, 30 APR, 7 MAY, and 18 JUN 2022)....And their Refresher Classes 23 APR and 12 May
