They covered the Ports of Monterey, Moss Landing, Santa Cruz, Half Moon Bay, Bodega Bay, Fort Bragg, and the Humbolt Bay AOR: This Activity resulted in:

34 Dockside Exams Completed, 24 CFVS Decals Issued, Two Safety Spot Checks

57 Safety Discussions with Fishing Vessel Operators. BZ to ALL Involved in this Activity.

The **Parks and Recreation Department asked** if the Auxiliary also might somehow assist with their **current Aquatic Species Nuisance problems**. Morgan Responded that Aquatic and Invasive Species is an area of concentration within the USCG and the USCGAUX and will be eventually getting back to them about the nature of their problem and what Boater / Public Education and other activities the Unit may Assist with in the future.

I am certain from general communications, that the current ADSO-MS's and most SO-MS Officers are continuing to work towards seeing that 2022 is as successful a year for the MS Department in 2022 as it was in 2021.
