HIGHLIGHTS:

1. Monitoring multiple wildfires.

DETAILS:

1. Due to the multiple wildfires across the west, we have been engaged in monitoring their location, advancement, and spread against the location of USCG AUX members. It was determined that some fires had no effect on AUX members. However, others were monitoring, preparing to evacuate or have evacuated.
 - a. Mosquito Fire in Foresthill, CA (Placer County) between Div. 113-03 and 113-11. One member of 113-03-01 was monitoring fire and ready to evacuate on 7 Sept.
 - b. As the fire grew, an Everbridge message was sent 14 Sept. for accountability purposes related to the Mosquito Fire. It was determined that three members had evacuated and nine were okay and did not need to evacuate. Initially, two members did not respond so that information was passed on to the DCDR for Div. 3. They received message indicating that the two members had traveled away from their home due to the smoke and that they were okay.
