District 11N DSO-PV Report for End of Year 2022

It is with great pleasure to say that District 11N RBS Program Visitors met and exceeded the goals set for the year 2022! As a matter of fact, we were 140% of our goal. It was accomplished by the hard work and dedication of 50 program visitors who chose to use their time to go out and deliver RBS literature to our partners for the public to freely take.

Special acknowledgement of Division 5 for achieving 288% of their goal with 959 visits and to Division 6 for reaching a 188% with 205 visits, Bravo Zulu.

The Program Visitor goals for 2023 are: to increase the number of visits by 2% from 2022, to have 65% of our visitors report their efforts (that would be 10 from the current 50 who did in 2022), and increase the number of RBS Program Visitors by 10% (we currently have 92 program visitors).
