





V PAC AREA Statistics



The NEW D11NR VSC goal for 2023 is 3,000 VSC's. Currently we are 125% of 2022 and have 20% of the PAC AREA VSC total. The data source is AUXDATA2*. Additional stats from AUXDATA2* indicates that 2558 or 77% have passed the VSC, 110 or 33% are First Time VSC's, and 92 or 27% are High Focus VSC's. In addition 21 Paddlecraft VSC's have been performed, which is approximately 6% of our total VSC production. We currently have 119 ACTIVE Vessel Examiners (VE's) which averages 2.8 VSC's per examiner. National average is 20 VSC's per examiner.

- -NEW-When performing a Facility Inspection on either form ANSC 7003(boat) or ANSC 7008(PWC), please make certain that \underline{ALL} boxes contain information in \underline{ALL} SECTIONS, I thru VII. If particular box requiring information is not needed, draw a circle with a line thru it (Θ) , or use "N.A." if that box does not apply. Leaving a box empty may imply missing information after the form reaches the DIRAUX office.
- -<u>NEW</u>-<u>PLEASE REMEMBER THAT THE VSC DECAL ALLOACATION PERIOD FOR</u>
 2024 ENDS JUNE 30,2023. PLEASE SUBMIT ALL OF YOUR VSC ACTIVITY PRIOR
 TO THE END OF JUNE.
- -NEW- 59 examiners of the D11NR Vessel Examiner corps or 49% of the 119 shown in AUXDATA2 have now completed the National workshop.

-NEW-When qualifying a NEW examiner, and making the entry into AUXDATA2, <u>PLEASE</u> make certain that you list the member as a "<u>TRAINEE</u>", and not as a <u>NON-LEAD</u>. Please refer to ANSC 7038 for the correct listing and please remind your FSO-IS to review for this important information.

-VSC's ON RENTALS-At the request of Commodore Kirkwood, and after 18-years, the VSC Rental Program was updated in 2019 and moving forward. <u>ANYONE</u> who performs rental VSC's on PWC's, fishing boats, houseboats, paddlecraft, etc. <u>MUST</u> be aware of the new changes in effect after 1 June 2019. Please go to the D11NR Vessel Examiner (VE) website: http://rbsafety.d11nuscgaux.info/ve/ve.html and review ML-1 thru ML-4 and closely review and follow the instructions as ALL of these forms have been revised and approved by DCO Kirkwood. -PLEASE do NOT wear boots to climb aboard a vessel to perform a VSC. Our program allows for deck shoes, white or black tennis/walking with soft soles. If this is not an option, please consider purchasing disposal shoe/boot covers available in the paint or hardware dept. at Wal-Mart, Lowes, Home Depot, etc, a package of 10 for about \$10.

Vational News

-NEW-ANSC has just received in a NEW Item: ANSC# 3021, a 3 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 2" (business card size) SARSAT/BEACON REGISTRATION INFORMATION CARD- EPIRB (NOAA). These are a pack of 50 per and should be handed out during VSC's especially in the coastal regions. They may be ordered by your FC or FSO-MA.

- -NEW-The USCG just released Marine Safety Alert 03-23, regarding DSC radios. While it is written for commercial vessels, everything in the alert also applies to recreational vessels with DSC radios. - -NEW- The 2023 MANDATORY "VSC Workshop" has been released by National. Please complete the Workshop ASAP and as in the past, it is "required" to be completed by June 30, 2023. As with previous workshops, this is not a heavy lift and should take no more than about 15-20 minutes.

The workshop is easily accessible and downloadable VE test answers 1 "b" pg 3-20 "A" 4-2 from your D11NR VE website: http://rbsafety.d11nuscgaux.info/ve/ve.html. Please fill out the "Self-Attestation" form and as in the past, submit the signed form to your FSO-IS Officer to be entered into AUXDATA2. Completing the VSC Workshop can be done individually on your phone or desktop, or as a group, but each Vessel Examiner is individually responsible to complete & submit their own Self-Attestation.

The 2023 workshop review includes:

- -Important educational talking points for Paddlecraft.
- -Information about PFD "Intended Use" Label changes.
- -Clarification about the new Fire Extinguisher requirements.
- -Uniform Requirements

This is a National workshop/review and if not completed by June 30, 2023, you will be in REWORK. Any VSC's performed AFTER cannot be entered into AUXDATA2. After December 31, 2023, you will be in REYR status and will still to complete to workshop plus complete 2 mentored VSC's.
