ADSO-Contingency Communications: Scholz:

This has been a fairly quiet month for the I&CC program. It began with a survey of the leadership in the program to develop a sense of intended direction for the next several months. There were 13 possible areas of focus for the 15 or so months. When the results were evaluated, six items were recommended for immediate planning and implementation. These six were primarily focused on integration between the two regional units and additional focus on training using the West Coast Region net (WESTNET) with on-line support and in integrating VHF comms resources into that net. More details on the other seven areas will be be forthcoming.

The immediate result is a change in the style of training methods and materials, focusing on a tool set known as "Drill Sheets". Implementation of this approach began in October and will continue to be put in place and used over the next several months. A description of the method and its use was given to the National Staff officer, Branch Chief for Communications Operations who overseas the four regional HF nets and is to whom I report for net operations. His response was positive and supportive.
