**New in AUXDATA**

In the Patrol Order object, there is now a place for Operators to check the status of their crew prior to the patrol date. Simply clicking the 'Crew Check' button, entering the competency and the member number or name, and clicking 'Verify Competencies'. The results window will show the status of the competency, the date of the next expiring task and if the member is night certified.

Operators are encouraged to use this tool when requesting orders to ensure the crew is certified at the time of the patrol.
