District Surface Safety Officer:

It is the responsibility of all members engaged and participating in the operations program to be fully aware of the challenges our differing operational areas present. Those members who conduct land mobile operations are encouraged to participate in the defensive driving course that has been offered from time to time at our PCA Fairs, and District Training Conference. Those members who actively participate in the surface operations program should constantly evaluate the missions and tasks they accept or assume. It is imperative that principles of TCT be followed to reduce potential risks. In the excitement of activity it is not uncommon for us in our desire to assist others to not fully analyze the situation and underestimate the complexity of our response. All Coxswains and Crewmembers should remember we represent the United States Coast Guard when under orders and should wear the authorized uniform properly and perform our duties in a professional manner.

Inland Operations:

We are studying the feasibility of preparing selected inland charts/fishing maps with a grid overlay to aid in tracking our facilities as well as to assist our boating safety partners in planning SAR activities. More information will follow regarding this initiative.
