### **DSO** Activities

On March 10, the Marine Safety Group held a ZOOM meeting to introduce all members, and go over multiple items. We also set up the marine safety classes and schedule for the spring of 2021.

#### Marine Enviroinvental Pollution Event

There in an ongoing pollution event in Marin/Sonoma County area, the American Challenger went aground off the Marin Coast on Friday March 5. The vessel has been assessed for oil spill potential and booms placed in the entrance of Tomales Bay. I have reached out to Sector IMD response to offer the assistance of the CG Auxiliary qualified members in Pollution Response, and SCAT training.

### Commercial Fishing Vessel and Uninspected Passenger Vessel Examinations.

National fisheries have opted to restrict the salmon fisheries and postponed the commercial and recreational fishery north of Pigeon Point. This will severely impact our CV fleet and acivity.

Also do not consider the ADV as your primary mission when requesting or conducting your patrols.
