GOALS AND OBJECTIVES:

2021 Goals:

From the Auxiliary 2020-2026 Strategic Plan:

"Expand Auxiliary Interpreter Corps augmentation - Accurately meet the interpreter and translation needs of the Coast Guard Director of International Affairs and Foreign Policy Coast Guard with qualified Auxiliary interpreters."

D11N Goals:

- Double the number of Interpreter and International affair mission hours in 2021, to a total of 75 hours
- Recruit and certify new Interpreters (revised)
 - Have 40 certified Interpreters in our District (currently we have 36)
- Educate 10 Auxiliary Units about the Interpreter Corps capabilities and engagement model
- Educate 10 USCG units about the Interpreter Corps capabilities and engagement model, directly or through the local Auxiliary units
