### HIGHLIGHTS:

- 1. Completed 2 Everbridge notification drills
- 2. The USCG OEM released the Emergency Management Credential program

### DETAILS:

- The first Everbridge notification drill was conducted on March 20<sup>th</sup> at 1200 hours. The notification
  was sent to EXCOM and DCDR's only. There was a 100% acknowledgement from all recipients of the
  alert. The second drill was conducted on March 27<sup>th</sup>. This was an All-Hands drill, which means the
  alert was sent to 1,137 members. There was a 77% acknowledgment from all recipients. The results
  of the drill were sent to the District Commodore for review.
- 2. Overview from the Application Guide: The Coast Guard Emergency Management Credential (CGEMC) Program is managed by the Coast Guard Office of Emergency Management (CG-OEM). The goal is to advance the emergency management profession within the Coast Guard by promoting the principles of emergency management. The CGEMC is available to any active duty (officer or enlisted), civilian, reserve (officer or enlisted), or auxiliary member who meets the training, experience, and test criteria, regardless of specialty or assigned duty station/position. The purpose of the published guide is to provide instructions on completing the certification process.
