- 2. The Emergency Management and Disaster Preparedness Directorate (Q) is initiating a beta testing of an Auxiliary Qualification Tracking Program.

DETAILS:

- 1. Bryce Leinan synched the Everbridge database. We will need to geocode again. Bryce is working with National on a way to export our members after he geocodes again, so we don't to do that every time.
- The Excel-spreadsheet-based program allows individual auxiliarists with Incident Command System (ICS), USCG, Auxiliary, professional, and other critical qualifications to identify their willingness to provide critical support to the Coast Guard and other government agencies.
