Details:

- 1. Currently, only IS Officers should be submitting Attestations, Core Training, and Workshops, through AUXDATA II. Members and Instructors need to work with their FSO/SO-IS to ensure accuracy, and that paperwork has been submitted appropriately. This comes from DIRAUX.
- 2. At this point in time, it is looking like we will be fortunate to have at least two IS members attending the AUX-10 C-School at NACON. As there is a possibility of one more, final announcement will be made once confirmed.
- 3. AUXDATA II Training is continuing at all levels. All members are encouraged to ask for assistance and training if needed/desired.
- 4. It appears that an increasing number of Elected and Appointed Officers are becoming more comfortable with AD2 Reports. Since everyone has access, it is relieving some of the strain on IS.
- 5. With as busy as Officers are, we sometimes require a reminder to submit our own hours. Please do! Every hour submitted into AD2, has a cash value to the USCG funds from Congress.

Projects:

- Provide continued AUXDATA II updates and training.
- Increase AUXDATA II training opportunities.

Challenges:

• Despite how easy AD2 really is, many members refuse to partake in the training, or ask for assistance.

Goals/Objectives:

- Increase the percentage of members using AUXDATA II.
- Increase the number of officers, at all levels, to get as comfortable, if not more so, using AD2 Reports, as they were with AUXINFO.
