Re: ASC-Humboldt Activity Report

Division 8: Continues to support Sector Humboldt through members' activities.

Flotilla 08-07: The Flotilla continues to maintain the fuel farm located at Point Arena Lighthouse which is critical to the Helo OPTs. The Flotilla cleaned the Point Arena lighthouse.

Flotilla 08-08: The Flotilla performed 3 boat patrols and 2 PWC patrols, using all currently certified OPFACS, crew, coxswains and PWC operators they also had 2 boat crew candidate trainees. They have also increased the number of their Vessel Safety Checks.

Flotilla 08-11: The Flotilla is exploring ways to get a facility to perform Aux Patrols. Currently Sector Humboldt is not able to get Auxiliary 29127 operational and maintain it per Coast Guard Regulations due to a man power shortage. A meeting was held on May 25th between the Auxiliary and Sector Humboldt Bay outlining the reasons why Auxiliary 29127 could not be made operational and maintained at this time.

Flotilla 08-39: The Flotilla provided two patrol boats with 6 crew members to maintain a security zone and assistance for distressed vessels at the 59th Annual Memorial Day Weekend Regatta on May 29 and 30, 2021. Whiskeytown Lake Moonlight kayaking patrols will resume on June 23 and end on August 22, 2021.

Sector Humboldt Bay had the D11 Admiral visit on June 9th and tenth, and Station Noyo River Change of Command on the 11th. BMCM Hinote (STA Humboldt Bay OIC) will official take over as Ancient Keeper during week of June 13th – 19th during the Change of watch ceremony in Michigan.
