We have received blanket authorization to resume and conduct all AUXSCOUT missions in the district subject to the following provisions:

- COVID-19 Guidance - All participating AUX members must comply with current DHS, USCG, USCGAUX, BSA, federal, state, and local COVID-19 guidelines.
- High Risk Assessment Form - All AUX members participating in the activity/event must have submitted a current HRAF to DIRAUX prior to participation.
- ATD Requests – the activity/event AUX lead must submit an ATD request (<https://www.emailmeform.com/builder/form/82bg2v202kxlb>) prior to the activity/event. The blanket-ATD covers the AUX lead and all AUX members participating in the activity/event and needs to be submitted by the lead only once unless the leads' health information changes since the last ATD submission.
