Division 3 Conducted a great Sea Partner, Beach Cleanyp

Division MS Report Highlights:

Division 1, Lilli Ferguson reported that there was a Beach Cleanup with flotilla 1-7 at Ocean Beach on October 17, and other FSO MS staff gave presentations on the two oil spills in CA (Huntington Beach, and Tomales Bay)

Division 3, Jeff Fite ran The Great Freeport Bridge Beach Cleanup 2021was conducted on 24 OCT 2021. Organized by Jeff Fite and attended by Don Anderson and Fred Black.

Division 5, Both Napa and Petaluma conducted some additional beach cleanup activity in October.

Div 6 Alex Urciuoli has a great report including MS related PA events, and promoting other MS messages to the public..

Div 10, Joseph Chavoen and his team have set up MEP based PA Booths in different locations covering cleanup and invasive species presentations.

DSO & ADSO Activities

On October 12, The USCG Auxiliary Marine Safety Team (DSO MS Sumner, ADSO Chaveon, ADSO Mitchell), USCG AUC, Sue Fry met the new head of Sector, Prevention, CDR Allegretti and IMD LT Bennett for both introductions and operational goats for 2022. This was a very successful meeting as many in Sector Prevention and Response are new to the Aux MS programs and had only limited background with the MS programs that D11NR has created and participate. We shared the member information of the D11NR marine safety qualifications, and goals for 2022.

Sea Partners Activity

Divisions 3,& 10 conducted Beach Clean up programs in October. See the specifics from Div 3.

The Great Freeport Bridge Beach Cleanup 2021was conducted on 24 OCT 2021. Organized by Jeff Fite and attended by Don Anderson and Fred Black. Collectively, the team removed 122.5 pounds of rubbish from the beach and parking area, with the single most numerous item being 201 cigarette butts. These are particularly bad for the environment, since they break down to microplastics that get into the food web, and when they do so they are laden with nicotine, tar, 40 other carcinogens, and more than 200 toxic chemicals. Also, two members of the public received training and materials in AWW principles. A well-earned BZ goes out to the team! organized a beach Cleanup day Saturday, October 23rd, at Freeport Bridge Beach

Abandoned Derelict Vessel

There was a very positive ADV Work Group meeting of 13 OCT lead by Lt. Brunke OSPER with the Introduction of Lt. Natasha Kenny the new SECSF ADV Rep. who we met again at the meeting on Yerba Buena Island with Chief of Prevention CDR Hals Allegtretti and his LCDR Prevention Leadership team

Commercial Fishing Vessel Exam.

The recreational crab fishery started with restrictions on November 6 and Commercial Crab season on November 23 if the humpback whale migration has not started. Operation CRAB SAFE, or inspections of commercial fishing vessels, will take place on November 8, 9 & 10 for the commercial fleet in ports from Santa Cru to Crescent City. More to come as this is a very large event for D11.
