Highlights:

- Bridge surveys and PATON verifications underway.
 - o There are 50 bridges to survey and 780 PATONs to verify.
- Use of Sector SD for Embedded at CSTA Alameda, Waterways Management, dpw work
- Overall excellent results for year

Details:

- 50 of 50 bridges (100%) have been surveyed to date. We have completed the Bridge survey period due date of May 31, 2021.
- 545 of 780 PATONs (75%) have been verified thus far. PATON verifications due date was September 30, 2021. This is a great result given Weather conditions, asset availability and personnel retirements/hesitancy due to covid that have all contributed to challenging goal obtainment.
- DPW has started work on adding backlog of Class II PATONs
 - o Installed 8 new Class II PATONs in Humboldt Bay
 - o Refining new digitized processes
 - o Enhancing Access db for usage by dpw and auxiliary
 - Working on backlog of PATON verification entries

National Interaction:

- Demoed new Access db "PATON Verification db" for USCG Research team to help kick off new Research program for standardizing (to the extent possible) PATON verification process for both the Coast Guard and the Auxiliary
- Continued working on planning for 2022 NS C Schools -currently projecting August class to be held at CGSTA Alameda initiated planning for August class.

Challenges/Obstacles/Opportunities:

- With Phase III upon us, Covid impacts of operations appear to be minimalized.
- Weather, as in, air quality, severely hampering outdoor activities (e.g. PATON verification) in Lake Tahoe area.

Agency Interaction:

- District 11 N/S has completed 100% of Class I, 45% of Class II and 27% of Class III verifications for 2021.
- Added 8 new PATONs to district stable
- Bob Bain (FL57) and Michael Hay (FL57) area continue working weekly at Waterways Management (dpw) as PATON Administrations. Bob Bain now, currently has VDI access from home for IATONIS access.
- Backlog of Class II PATONs in progress making headway

Goals & Objectives:

- **COMPLETED**: 100% surveys of 50 bridges for 11N *Work underway* 50 of 50 completed
- 100% verifications of 780 PATONs for 11N completed 75% fpr the year
- Completed: Produce and distribute electronic bridge survey sheets for 50 bridges in 11N by the end of January
- Completed: Produce and distribute 2273 electronic and printed PATON sheets for both both 11N & 11S by mid-February.

The Future of NOAA Charts (& RNC Cancellations)

The Issue

With the retirement of RNC charts occurring now through 2025, Auxiliarists need to keep themselves apprised of what updated chart products are still acceptable.

Previously we considered RNC paper charts our primary navigational chart source. But with the advent of robust Electronic Chart Systems (ECS, chart-plotters) for recreational craft in the last decades, many Districts have been transitioning to ECS for their on-water navigation requirements.

Now that NOAA is actively retiring the RNC paper charts, there will be locations where an RNC paper chart will be obsolete. They should not be used for on-water operations or on NS missions. (One could make the case for continuing to use outdated charts for MT and PE activities as long as the presenters make it clear that the materials are obsolete and only being used for training purposes).

The last new edition of an RNC chart was Nov., 2020. Between now and the RNC Chart retirements, only LNM-worthy corrections are being applied to RNC products by the Print-On-Demand Vendors. (In contrast, the ENC data files are updated weekly.)

Updated Chart Information

Although a few ECS apps have the ability to download the NOAA ENC data file every week, most units being purchased by members only have the ability to sign-up for annual updates. In those cases, the facility owner should keep themselves apprised of the chart changes through NOAA's chart changes link/s: https://nauticalcharts.noaa.gov/charts/chart-updates.html

ECS Back-up

After the transition from RNCs, it is my recommendation <u>if</u> a coxswain or facility so desire, they consider including a separate device (i.e., a tablet) in addition to their boat's ECS. This completely independent system essentially parallels one of the requirements for vessels having carriage requirements (cargo ships, tankers, etc.)

Paper Products, Post RNC Retirement

NOAA is in conversation with several Print-On-Demand (POD) Vendors about their plans to create a paper chart from ENC data files. The progress for this effort will be discussed in upcoming NOAA webinars in late 2021 and early 2022. These products would be considered "certified" by NOAA. But presently, the certification addresses colors, paper stock, position registration,.. but does not include which ENC attributes need to be included. It is crusical that we keep ourselves updated on NOAA's progress with POD Vendor products.

Although the actual retirements just started, it will speed up soon.
